

Dear participants of the IIC in Vienna,

First of all, we would like to express our gratitude for the numerous registrations for the 170th IIC in Vienna! We are excited to welcome nearly 500 participants from 30 nations and look forward to a successful and informative weekend.

Preparations for the IIC began approximately a year ago. The team of the national association ITF Austria focused on detailed planning, starting with the renting of a suitable sports facility with the necessary infrastructure. The HAKOAH sports hall of the "Israelitische Kultusgemeinde", with a training area of 1200m2, was the first choice. Corresponding contractual agreements and advance payments were made. Collaboration and preliminary meetings in the ongoing planning process were always constructive. The hall is available to all faiths for sports and cultural events, and the organizing team has been consistently professional.

A few days ago, the "Israelitische Kultusgemeinde" decided to cancel all planned events in Jewish sports and cultural venues due to a significantly increased security threat. We deeply regret this situation and understand this decision, even though it has had a massive impact on the organization of the IIC.

For this reason, we were challenged to find a suitable alternative venue within a few days. Due to the tight time frame and the necessary requirements (size, accessibility, amenities), this search was extremely difficult.

Fortunately, we were able to secure a hall with appropriate dimensions. The available sports hall has a training area of around 1400m2 and has received approval from the technical committee. However, one challenge is the accessibility; the new hall in "Vienna Strebersdorf" is unfortunately not as centrally located as the originally planned HAKOAH hall. While public transportation is available, it may pose challenges for international participants. Therefore, we will provide a bus shuttle service.

**Please provide feedback by Monday, Nov 13**<sup>th</sup>, if you would like to use the shuttle service. It is expected to start near the Vienna Ernst Happel Stadium (Subway station "Stadion" on the U2 line) and directly reach the new hall in "Vienna Strebersdorf".

We look forward to a joint and instructive Taekwon-Do seminar, and to meeting many international friends again in Vienna!

# Parking facilities at the training hall
